

CASABLANCA EXCURSION

Casablanca is the largest gateway to the Maghreb even busier than Marseille, the city on which it was modeled by the French.

A city tour of Casablanca should include the central market, the Habous district, the Royal Palace, Place Mohamed V, the residential district of Anfa and a complete visit to the famous Hassan II mosque.

You will stop at Mohamed V Square after passing through United Nations Square. It's worth delving into the nearby Central Market, an upscale souk whose wares are offered to locals, to get a glimpse of daily life in the city. It is essentially a market for food products and crafts. If you want a place to cook, you could even buy some turtles, for the soup!

The visit of the interior of the Hassan II mosque: built for the 60th birthday of the former Moroccan king Hassan II, is the largest religious monument in the world after Mecca.
